

## **Some Area Dog Parks:**

### **Clayton**

Clayton Dog Park

Marsh Creek Road, across from Clayton Park

Open sunrise to sunset;

Fenced, benches, tables, handicap access, poopbags, trash.

### **Concord**

The City of Concord maintains a .8 acre Dog Off Leash Exercise Area. It is located in the Lime Ridge Open Space area. The site is rustic and composed of quarry waste material. There is limited shade, several benches, fresh water provided daily for dogs, and pooper scooper stations, not fenced. Take Treat Boulevard to San Miguel Road to the Via Montanas entrance of Lime Ridge Open Space to the dog run.

**Newhall Community Park** - 126 acres along Galindo Creek east of Treat Boulevard. Access is via Newhall Parkway south of Clayton Road or from Turtle Creek Road. Galindo Creek meanders through the park. Approximately 30 acres of park is improved with ponds along the creek, picnic areas, bocce courts, and turfed athletic fields. The "Paw Patch" is a secure, fenced area where dogs can exercise off-leash. There is one reservable group picnic area in a secluded creekside setting with large oak trees. Most of the park is undeveloped open space. Over two miles of multi-use trails, linked to the regional network, are available for walkers, hikers, joggers, bicyclists and horseback riders. From the top of the hill, one is rewarded with sweeping views from the Carquinez Straits to Mount Diablo. A Vietnam War Memorial graces the vista point.

### **Danville**

**HAP MAGEE RANCH CANINE CORRAL** - 1025 La Gonda Way. Hours of operations - dawn to dusk.  
1.5 acre

Permanent small dog area to be built in November 2004. Please use the current temporary area for dogs under 20 lbs.

#### **Directions to the dog park traveling Southbound on 680**

Traveling South on 680 take the El Pintado Rd exit turn right onto El Pintado. Turn right onto La Gonda Way at the stop sign. The park is on the left after the stop sign on La Gonda Way. Please park in the paved parking lot.

#### **Directions to the dog park traveling Northbound on 680**

Traveling North on 680 take the El Cerro Rd exit turn right onto El Cerro at the light. Turn right onto La Gonda Way at the second light. The park is on the left after the stop sign on La Gonda Way. Please park in the paved parking lot.

### **Lafayette**

Briones Reserve - part of East Bay Regional Park District

Enter trails on Bear Creek Road, Alhambra Valley Road. Dogs are allowed off-leash if they are under strict voice control. Miles of trails and several cattle ponds for dog swimming.

### **Livermore**

1/ Max Baer Park

Murdell Lane and Stanley Blvd

fenced, handicap access, trees, parking, trash

## 2/ Lake Del Valle

Follow Livermore Avenue to Mines Road, the Lake is 8 miles up the road. Parking fee. Park by the boat ramp and keep dog onleash until through the gate past the boatramp - this is the off-leash area. Be aware: active fishing area, so you may want to keep dogs on leash until out of fishing zone.

## 3/ May Nissen Park

685 Rincon Avenue at Pine

fenced, benches, trees, parking, lights, water, trash

comments: has a fenced dog run

## **Pleasant Hill**

Located on Paso Nogal Road at Morello Avenue

hours are dawn to dusk Mon - Fri., 9am to dusk Sat., closed Sunday;

fenced, benches, tables, handicap access, trees, parking, water, trashcans;

comments: recently fenced and with expanded hours, the park also has open space trails where dogs are allowed on-leash.

## **Pleasanton**

MuirWood Park

On Muirwood

From Stoneridge, take Springdale and turn left onto Muirwood. park is on the left. Benches, poopbags, trees, parking, water, trashcans. The park is all tan bark rather than grass - dusty in the heat but easier for poop cleanup.

## **Richmond**

parkname = Point Isabell

cross streets = Central Ave exit off 580

benches, tables, handicap, poop bags, trees, parking, phones, water, trash cans, shelter

other comments = This park is located right on the water. Dogs have a blast running, swimming, retrieving, and romping! Pet grooming shop at the park, weekend coffee/snack bar.
